- Effectively arrange music timetables for all pupils and instruments, and to be able to adapt these (often at short notice) in response to other activities/events taking place within the school
- Communicate with parents during the year as appropriate
- Write end of year reports for the pupils
- Support the Music Coordinator in preparing the students for recitals and concerts
- Provide opportunities for ensemble playing as appropriate
