Introduction

At Aldenham we believe that financial limitations should never stand in the way of academic excellence, talent, and ambition. Our scholarship programs are designed to recognize outstanding students, reward hard work, and support families in making quality education accessible to all. Whether you're a high achiever, a dedicated leader, an exceptional artist, or someone with a compelling story, there's a scholarship opportunity waiting for you. There are two levels of recognition: the Scholarship Award, which offers a 10% reduction in fees, and the Exhibition Award which provides a 5% reduction.

Academic Scholarships for 11+ and 13+ are awarded based on student performance and do not require an application. These scholarships celebrate academic excellence and are granted for excellent performance in the entrance assessment.

Information on how to apply for other scholarships can be found below.

Current students may be considered for a scholarship should the relevant Head of Department recommend them, there is not a formal application.

Please note that the scholarship process runs independently of the admissions process and that an invitation to a scholarship audition or trial should not be taken as a guarantee of a school place.

Additionally, the scholarship process for entry at 11+ takes place during your child's Year 6 while for entry at 13+ it takes place during your child's Year 8.

Art Scholarship

Thank you for your interest in our Art Scholarship. Please note that artistic ability is not a means of entry to Aldenham in its own right, and attendance at the Interview will be by invitation based on a combination of the scholarship application form, reference and digital images submitted. Please also be aware that scholarship funds are limited.

Who we are looking for

Applicants should be able to demonstrate genuine enthusiasm for Art and have developed drawing ability and creativity in their manipulation of a variety of media, ideas and approaches. Successful candidates will be expected to show not only a high level of technical skill, but, more importantly, imagination, originality and a palpable commitment to the subject. There is an ongoing expectation that they will have regular review meetings with the art department.

Candidates should be able to demonstrate in their work:

- consistently gaining some of the top grades in their year group
- exceptional control over more than one material creating art/design work which demonstrates complexity and sensitivity beyond the level expected for the year group
- self-direction and further engagement with the subject matter both in and outside of the classroom
- the ability to analyse artwork and communicate ideas to an outstanding level.

Process & timings

Application Form & Reference

Those who indicate their interest in an Art Scholarship on the Registration Form will be asked to complete an application form, provide references and images of their artwork.

Interview

Subject to their scholarship application form, selected applicants will be invited to a drawing session and interview with the Director of Art in January. During the interview, students will have the opportunity to talk about their school artwork/sketchbook and will be asked questions about art, such as, what they enjoy in the arts, favourite artworks or shows or exhibitions they may have found inspiring. They should bring some of their artwork.

We will send out invitations as soon as possible after applications have been received.

Decision

Scholarship decisions will be communicated to families as part of offer letters.

The Scholarship Package

- A scholarship at Full Scholar Level attracts a fee remission of 10% off day fees subject to continued high standards of work and commitment and an annual review.
- A scholarship at Exhibition Level attracts a fee remission of 5% off day fees subject to continued high standards of work and commitment and an annual review.

Dance Scholarship

Please also be aware that scholarship funds are limited.

Who we are looking for

Applicants should be heavily involved with Dance activities, preferably both in and out of school and have a genuine appreciation of the Dance. They should have experience of performing in a Dance Show.

Process & timings

Application Form & Reference

Those who indicate their interest in a Dance Scholarship on the Registration Form will be asked to complete an application form and provide references.

Audition

Subject to their scholarship application form selected applicants will be invited to Audition with the Head of Dance in January. Attendees will need to come prepared to perform two dance pieces in two different genres (styles). The dances should be between one minute and one minute thirty seconds.

They will need to bring their own accompaniment (music). There will also be an interview with the Head of Dance.

We will send out invitations as soon as possible after applications have been received.

Decision

Scholarship decisions will be communicated to families as part of offer letters.

Successful candidates will be expected to show not only a high level of technical skill, but, more importantly, imagination, originality and a palpable commitment to the subject.

Candidates should be able to demonstrate in their work:

- the ability to sketch and design imaginative concepts
- the ability to construct a project outcome which demonstrates complexity and dexterity beyond the level expected of the year group
- independent and further engagement with the subject matter both in and outside of the classroom
- the ability to critically analyse design/ completed projects and communicate ideas to an outstanding level.

Those who indicate their interest in a Design and Technology Scholarship on the Registration form will be asked to complete an application form, provide references and images of their projects.

Interview

Subject to their scholarship application form selected applicants will be invited to an Interview with the Head of DT in January. During the interview, students will have the opportunity to talk about their school designing and project work and will be asked questions about the design world, such as what they enjoy, favourite designers or shows or exhibitions they may have found inspiring. They need to bring with them a portfolio or photographs of their projects.

Process & timings

Application Form & Reference

Those who indicate their interest in a Drama Scholarship on the Registration form will be asked to complete an application form and provide references.

Audition / Interview

Subject to their scholarship application form selected applicants will be invited to an acting workshop and interview with the Director of Drama in January.

We will send out invitations as soon as possible after applications have been received.

Decision

Scholarship decisions will be communicated to families as part of offer letters.

The Scholarship Package

- A scholarship at Full Scholar Level attracts a fee remission of 10% off day fees and free individual LAMDA lessons at approximately one a week, equivalent to an additional 5% fee remission, subject to continued high standards of work and commitment and an annual review.
 - A scholarship at Exhibition Level attracts free individual LAMDA lessons at approximately one a week, equivalent to 5% fee remission, subject to continued high standards of work and commitment and an annual review.

Our Expectations

- All scholars are expected to be seen as ambassadors for the department within the school.
 - Drama Scholars are expected to choose Drama as one of their GCSE options, and to commit to taking part in School productions, though please note that a Drama Scholarship does not guarantee a leading role in our productions.

Music Scholarship

Thank you for your interest in our Music Scholarship. Please note that musical ability is not a means of entry to Aldenham in its own right, and attendance at the Interview/ Audition will be by invitation based on a combination of the scholarship application and reference submitted. Please also be aware that scholarship funds are limited.

Who we are looking for

Applicants should be around a Grade 3 standard on two different orchestral instruments/voice, or a higher standard if only offering one instrument/voice. They should also be heavily involved in Music activities/orchestras/choirs/bands in or out of school.

Process & timings

Application Form & Reference

Those who indicate their interest in a Music Scholarship on the Registration form will be asked to complete an application form and provide references.

Audition / Interview

Subject to their scholarship application selected applicants will be invited to an Audition/ Interview with the Director of Music in January. Attendees will perform a piece on each instrument or two contrasting pieces, if only offering one instrument, complete a sight-reading assessment, aural test and interview.

We will send out invitations as soon as possible after applications have been received.

Decision

Scholarship decisions will be communicated to families as part of offer letters.

The Scholarship Package

- A scholarship at Full Scholar Level attracts a fee remission of 10% off day fees and free individual music instrumental lessons at approximately one a week, equivalent to an additional 5% fee remission, subject to continued high standards of work and commitment and an annual review.
 - A scholarship at Exhibition Level attracts free individual music instrumental lessons at approximately one a week, equivalent to 5% fee remission, subject to continued high standards of work and commitment and an annual review.

Our Expectations

- All scholars are expected to be seen as ambassadors for the department within the school.
 - Music Scholars are expected to attend choir and one other enrichment activity appropriate to their instrument/voice.
- Music Scholars are expected to choose Music as one of their GCSE options.

Sports Scholarship

Thank you for your interest in our Sports Scholarship. Please note that sporting ability is not a means of entry to Aldenham in its own right, and attendance at the Interview/ Trials will be by invitation based on a combination the scholarship application form and reference submitted. Please also be aware that scholarship funds are limited.

Who we are looking for

Applicants should be playing at a high level in TWO of the focus sports played at Aldenham, which are:

Boys: Football, Cricket, Hockey, Tennis.

Girls: Netball, Football, Cricket, Hockey, Tennis.

As a guide, a high level of performance would equate to an excellent School First Team player with the ability to significantly influence the outcome of a match in a positive way. Alternatively, a Sports Scholarship may be awarded to a candidate who is currently in an 'Academy' (or similar) programme in a ONE of our focus sports. However, all scholars would be expected to represent the school in at least two sports.

Application Form & Reference

Those who indicate their interest in a Sports Scholarship on the Registration form will be asked to complete an application form and provide references.

Trials

Subject to their scholarship application form selected applicants will be invited to Trials with the Director of Sport in January

Attendees will take part in the sports listed above, plus fitness testing.

We will send out invitations as soon as possible after applications have been received.

Scholarship decisions will be communicated to families as part of offer letters.
